


	embroidery needle
	• split pin
	What are you going to do?
	1 Cut out the square on the cut-out sheet.
	2 Cut out the white semicircle in the square.
	Important! Make sure you do not cut out the black/grey circle in the centre.
	3 Use the embroidery needle to prick a hole in the middle.
	4 Prick a hole in the centre of the world from Task 1.
	5 Place the square on top of the world.
	6 Push the split pin through the two holes as shown in the drawing below.
	7 Open the split pin to fasten it.
